ADA Person	A wide range of physical or mental impairment/disability
BHCS Client	A BHCS client is any individual who is assigned an LOC 1-4 while incarcerated at Santa Rita Jail.
Homeless	Someone is considered homeless if their housing status meets the Alameda County Health Homelessness Definition Click here for more information from Alameda County Health.

LOC	<p>Level of Care is an Alameda County Behavioral Health Department protocol. A client's LOC represents the client's current presentation and functioning.</p> <p>Click here for more information from the Behavioral Health Department.</p>
Severely Mentally Ill	SMI reflects that AFBH has determined that a client (any client LOC 1-4) has a qualifying SMI mental health diagnosis.
Sentencing	Anyone who is going to serve their sentences at Santa Rita Jail
X	Typically an individual in custody in another jurisdiction; but held in Santa Rita Jail for a local court case.
O	Uncategorized data field used in rare instances that require further reconciliation
No Housing	Has not been assigned a housing unit; typically a newly booked person
ITR	Intake Transfer and Release
OPHU	Out Patient Housing Unit
